Instructions: Glass Polishing Kit



Your kit contains:

- 100g x Cerium Oxide Polishing Powder
- 1 x Mandrel
- 2 x Large Polishing Discs (25mm)
- 2 x Small Polishing Discs (15mm)
- 3 x Pointed Polishing Tips (19mm length)

Instructions:

- 1. Attach the mandrel to the Dremel rotary tool and screw on your polishing disc or polishing tip.
- 2. Mix a small amount of the powder and water to make a milk-like mixture. Then apply thinly to the polishing disc or glass.
- 3. On a medium speed, move the polishing head over the glass. Keep the head moving as holding it in the same spot will cause friction heat which can cause glass to crack.
- 4. Apply more cerium oxide mixture as needed.

Please note: Polishing is the last stage in coldworking. Surfaces will not polish unless they have been finished to a minimum of 1800 grit before the cerium oxide is used to produce a high gloss finish.
